### **Authority**

The District shall provide resource materials that implement, support and enrich the educational program of district schools.[\[1\]](#)[\[2\]](#)[\[3\]](#)

### **Definition**

**Resource materials** shall include nonfiction and fiction books, magazines, reference books, supplementary titles, multimedia and digital materials, software and instructional material.

### **Delegation of Responsibility**

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for the recommendation and approval of all resource materials. No adoption or change of materials shall be made without the Superintendent's recommendation, except by a two-thirds vote of the Board.[\[2\]](#)

The Superintendent or designee may establish administrative regulations for the selection of resource materials.

A list of resource materials utilized by the District shall be maintained by the Building Principal or designee (teachers) and shall be available to Board

members, district staff, students, parents/guardians and community members upon request. [\[4\]](#)
