

3014 Information Systems Policy

The District recognizes its legal, financial, and ethical responsibilities for the acquisition, application and protection of its information systems resources. Administrative regulations will be established and enforced ensuring that plans and procedures are in place to:

1. Outline proper acquisition procedures;
2. Account for physical resources;
3. Protect information systems resources from risks and exposures;
4. Identify access guidelines, procedures, and authorizations;
5. Maintain the resources throughout reasonable operating life cycles; and,
6. Provide for proper and orderly disposal when appropriate.

Addendum to School Board Policy #3014 – Information Systems Policy

The District shall comply with the Federal Communications Commission's Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA).

Policy 3027 (Use of the District's Internet and Computer Networks) and Policy 3014 (Information Systems Policy) apply to all students, employees, ECA positions, visitors and volunteers using the School District's internet service or computer network, or any School District owned device, software, application, digital technology or system whether on the School District premises or in any location away from the School District premises, including at home. In addition, this policy applies to any non-School District owned device using the District's network, systems or Internet connection.
