

7015 Terroristic Threats

The School District recognizes the danger that terroristic threats and acts present to the safety and welfare of District students, staff, officials, volunteers and the local community. The District prohibits any person from communicating terroristic threats or committing terroristic acts directed at any student, employee, Board member, community member, school buildings or District property.

A "terroristic threat" is a threat to commit violence communicated with the intent to terrorize another, to cause evacuation of a building, or to cause serious public inconvenience, in reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror or inconvenience.

A "terroristic act" shall mean the carrying out of a terroristic threat against a person or property.

Staff members and students shall be responsible for informing the building principal regarding any information or knowledge relevant to a possible or actual terroristic threat or act.

When an administrator has evidence that a person has made a terroristic threat or committed a terroristic act, the following guidelines shall be applied:

1. The building principal shall promptly report the incident to the Superintendent.
2. Based on further investigation, the Superintendent or principal may report the person to law enforcement officials and bring charges against the person.
