

COMMUNITY BASED LEARNING (CBL)

General Information

- CBL is an elective course open to juniors and seniors.
- Students receive a Pass/Fail grade upon completion of the program.
- Students receive one credit for completing CBL.
- CBL may count as a student's fifth class in order to fulfill the Upper St. Clair High School requirement that students take a minimum of 5 classes during each semester.
- Students must follow the Upper St. Clair School District Driving Policy when traveling to and from CBL, and they must submit all appropriate paperwork.
- Students are responsible for securing a CBL site and site supervisor.
- Students are responsible for meeting with their counselors to add a fifth class -- IF they choose to drop CBL from their schedules.
