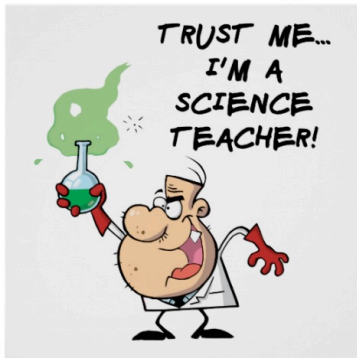


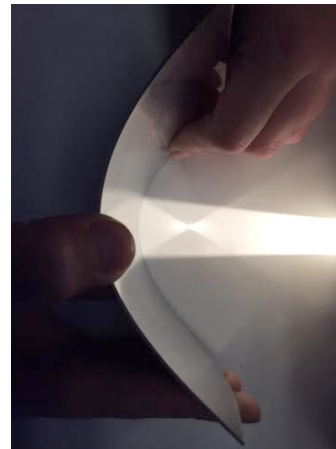

## Classroom Policies:

\_\_\_ 1. Lab safety is a major concern. Students are expected to follow all lab safety procedures outlined on the safety contract.

\_\_\_ 2. All assignments are due at the beginning of class. Assignments will typically be turned into an app called SHOWBIE. If the assignment is not turned in it will be considered late and **MUST BE EMAILED**. Assignments not received or incomplete will receive half credit if brought the next day.

\_\_\_ 3. All assignments need to be submitted **before** missing class for early dismissals, sporting events, band, or chorus. Following an absence, it is the responsibility of the student to **turn in and receive** all assignments that are missed. 2 days out = 2 days to make up the work.

\_\_\_ 4. If a student misses three assignments within a term parents will be contacted.

Catagory:	Description:
Daily Performance	This includes participation, preparation, homework completion, behavior...etc.
Academic Knowledge	This includes graded quizzes, tests, labs, and projects.

## Evaluation Guidelines:

- Work habits for assignments may also be evaluated. This includes: preparation, cooperation, independent work habits, following directions, respect for others, participation, and completion of assignments.
- Students will have the option to retake any test (unless otherwise specified by the teacher). If they choose to take a retest they are required to fill out a test repair form to correct their mistakes. Please be advised that the retest will be more difficult than the original.
- An overall evaluation will be given comparing the student's academic knowledge and their daily performance. This evaluation will be given as an O (outstanding), G (good), S (satisfactory), N (needs improvement), U (unsatisfactory), and I (incomplete) on the report card.
