#### Types of sentences

DECLARATIVE SENTENCE makes a statement and ends with a PERIOD. A DECLARATIVE SENTENCE declares or states something.

INTERROGATIVE SENTENCE is a sentence of inquiry that ASKS for a reply. It ends with a QUESTION MARK.

EXCLAMATORY SENTENCE expresses strong emotion, and it ends with an EXCLAMATION POINT.

IMPERATIVE SENTENCE gives advice or instructions, or expresses a request or command. Imperative sentences end with a PERIOD or an EXCLAMATION POINT.
